

Faculty Admission Requirements

All applicants to undergraduate studies in the Faculty of Arts must satisfy the Faculty's undergraduate admission requirement, which consists of KPU's undergraduate English proficiency requirement.

OPEN-INTAKE AREAS OF STUDY

Applicants for open intake admission may identify intended areas of study from among the following:

Applicants who do not designate an intended area of study will be identified as **Exploratory**.

LIMITED-INTAKE PROGRAMS

Limited-intake programs have a limit on the maximum number of students admitted per application cycle. Refer to the Admission Requirements section in individual program pages for details:

- Education Assistant

Applicants who satisfy both the program and Faculty undergraduate admission requirements will be offered admission to the Faculty with direct entry into the designated limited-intake program, as space permits. If space does not permit, such applicants will be offered open-intake admission to undergraduate studies in the Faculty.

Applicants to limited-intake programs who meet Faculty undergraduate admission requirements but who do not satisfy limited-intake program admission requirements will be offered open intake admission to undergraduate studies in the Faculty.

PATHWAY TO UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES
