- 1. Intellectual Achievement The degree of intellectual achievement or quality of ingenious thinking and experiment to discover, create or conceive the innovation.
- Uniqueness and Originality Refers to the state of being original; the freshness of aspect, design or style utilized to produce the invention.
- **3. Development** Refers to the extent to which the idea or concept has been thought through to completion.
- 4. **Commercialization** Refers to the degree of successful commercialization or quantifiable impact of the innovation.
- **5. Benefits** Refers to the economic and/or social benefit to Canada resulting from the innovation.
