



# Collaborative Online International Learning Proposal

## Introduction

Collaborative Online International Learning (COIL) is an approach that brings students and professors together across cultures to learn, discuss, and collaborate as part of their class. Professors partner to design the experience and students partner to complete the activities designed. COIL becomes part of the curriculum, enabling all students to foster their global competencies through an intercultural learning environment that links classes in different countries. Using various communication technologies, students from different countries complete shared assignments and projects, with faculty members from each country co-teaching.

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## Purpose

Typical COIL courses match faculty and students in similar courses from similar areas of study. The purpose of this proposal is for Kwantlen Polytechnic University (KPU) faculty who has a COIL project in mind to seek a partner professor from KPU partner institution abroad.
