Front-End Development for Interactive Applications

KPU is proud to announce the launch of our new Front-End Development for Interactive Applications diploma, through the Wilson School of Design.

Our Front-End Development program is designed to empower students with the skills and knowledge needed to create stunning, user-friendly websites and applications that leave a lasting impact. The diploma program is intended for students who are interested in web development, coding, design, and user interface and experience.

Admission Requirements consist of KPU's undergraduate English Proficiency Requirement, which is the completion of BC English Studies 12 with a minimum grade of C+.

Bachelor of Science in Health Science Co-op Program

KPU has launched a new Co-op Program for the Bachelor of Science in Health Science (including Honours). The Health Science Co-op program helps students gain invaluable experience that sets them apart in the competitive healthcare landscape.

BSc Health Science Co-op students work with a variety of industries such as the federal and provincial governments, municipalities, private businesses, and non-profit organizations. Potential roles include: Laboratory Technician, Biomedical Researcher, Hospital Administrator, Public Health and Safety Worker, Pharmacy Assistant, Rehabilitation Therapist, and Recreation Worker.

The program has started accepting applications, and the first term began in Spring 2024.

Nursing/Psychiatric Nursing

The new nursing program format offers increased flexibility for entry requirements.

Students can now apply to an open intake KPU program to complete their admissions requirements for nursing or psychiatric nursing, and then re-apply to the nursing program in year 2.

High school students cannot directly apply to BSN/BPN. Students will need the following high school prerequisites to be eligible to fulfill the Undergraduate Admission requirements for BSN/BPN:

- » Biology 12 (B) or Anatomy and Physiology 12 (B)
- » Chemistry 11 (B)
- » BC English Studies 12 (C+)

Education Assistant Program

KPU has recently updated the Admission Requirements for the Education Assistant Certificate program. Admission Requirements now consist of:

- » KPU's undergraduate English Proficiency Requirement, which is BC English Studies 12 with a minimum grade of C+.
- » A letter of intent, of about 500 words in length, addressing:
 - Your understanding of the role of an Education Assistant in K-12 schools
 - The qualities you possess that make you a good candidate for this work
- » One reference letter from a referee who can speak to your suitability for the work of an Education Assistant

After students have been admitted to the Education Assistant program they are required to provide:

» An acceptable Criminal Record Check through the Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General's Criminal Records Review Program within 6 months of the start of the program.

Applicants no longer need to complete the previous requirement of 100 hours of successful experience volunteering or working with children or youth.

Bachelor of Interior Design Honours Program

We are pleased to announce that students in the Bachelor of Interior Design degree program will have the option of pursuing a Bachelor of Interior Design Honours.

The Bachelor of Interior Design (Honours) is the first in western Canada and allows students to advance their design knowledge by investigating a topic of interest and working interdependently on an individually focused interior design project in Year 4 of the program. Students in the Interior Design program may now declare an intention to apply for an Honours Degree in their third year of the program. At the time of declaration, the student must satisfy all of the following requirements:

- » In good academic standing with the University
- » Completion of IDSN 1101, IDSN 1222, IDSN 2303, IDSN 2404, IDSN 3505, and IDSN 3606 with a minimum GPA of 3.3
- » Completion of all other required courses for Years 1 through 3 of the Bachelor of Interior Design degree with a minimum grade of C
- » Approval by the Interior Design Honours Committee for admittance to the Honours degree program

Indigenous Student Tuition Waivers

- » Satisfy level E1 as defined by the Math Alternatives Table, which is Pre-Calculus 11 (C), Foundations of Mathematics 11 (C+), or equivalent.

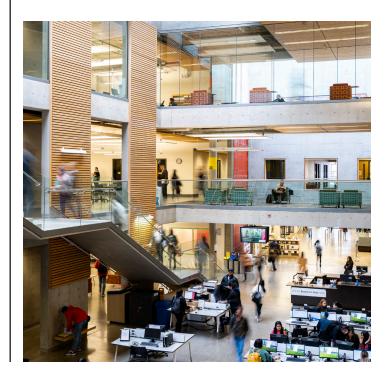
