


- Normal measures how hard you are pressed into surface.
- If you fall off a cliff you feel light as a feather ('til you hit).
- Lose contact with a surface N → 0





- Normal is your sense of weight.
- You feel heavier in an elevator accelerating upwards b/c floor is a ↑ pushing harder.
 - Real weight mg is constant
 - Another name "Apparent Weight"
 - Lose contact with a surface
 N → 0
 - One N for each surface OHQ
