



KWANTLEN POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY – 2018 NEW STUDENT TECH ORIENTATION CONTEST Official Contest Rules and Regulations

Participation in the 2018 New Student Tech Orientation Contest (the "Contest") constitutes the entrant's full and unconditional agreement with and acceptance of these Official Contest Rules and Regulations ("Official Rules") and all decisions of Kwantlen Polytechnic University ("Kwantlen" or the "Sponsor") and its agents, which are final on all matters relating to the Contest.

1. ELIGIBILITY

Entrants must be a resident of BC, aged 16 or older. Faculty and staff of KPU are not eligible. All provincial, municipal and federal laws and regulations apply.

2. HOW TO ENTER

To enter, entrants must attend orientation and complete an entry ballot and submit it to an orientation staff member at KPU Tech, 5500 180 Street, Surrey before 2:30pm PST on Thursday, August 30, 2018 to receive one (1) contest entry. One entry per person.

3. WINNER SELECTION

Four (4) entries (each a "selected entrant") will be randomly drawn at 2:45pm, PST in the Atrium, KPU Tech Campus, 5500 180 Street, Surrey, from all eligible entries at the New Student Tech Orientation on Thursday, August 30, 2018 (the "Contest Draw").

Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.

Subject to the Prize Claim conditions outlined below, the selected entrants will be awarded one (1) Prize (defined below). Prizes must be accepted as awarded.

The selected entrant will be announced immediately following the Contest Draw in the Atrium, KPU Tech, 5500 180 Street, Surrey, during New Student Tech Orientation. The announcement will be made by an orientation staff member at the event.

4. PRIZE CLAIM CONDITIONS

The selected entrants will be notified by public announcement at 2:45pm PST in the Atrium, KPU Tech, 5500 180 Street, Surrey during the New Student Tech Orientation on Thursday, August 30, 2018.

The selected entrants must be in attendance on Thursday, August 30, 2018 at 2:45pm PST, the time of the prize draw, at the New Student Tech Orientation at KPU Tech, 5500 180 Street, Surrey to claim their prize.

Photo Identification is required.

Before being declared a "Winner", the selected entrants must first correctly answer without assistance of any kind, whether mechanical or otherwise, a time-limited mathematical skill-testing question to be administered at the time the selected individual presents his/herself at the campus locations listed under the Winner Selection section of these contest rules and regulations during the New Student Tech Orientation. Selected entrants will also be required to complete a written declaration and prize release form, releasing the Sponsor and all of their respective directors, officers, owners, partners, shareholders, employees, agents, representatives, successors and assigns from any liability in connection with the Contest or the use or misuse or possession of any Prize. Failure of the selected entrant to present his/herself immediately following the announcement, failure to provide proof of eligibility, release documents, or other required documentation (if requested) in a timely manner, failure to correctly answer the skill-testing question, or other non-compliance with these Official Rules may result in disqualification, forfeiture of the Prize and, at Sponsor's sole discretion, selection of an alternate eligible entrant for the forfeited Prize, who will be subject to disqualification in the same manner.

5. DEADLINES

Contest begins on Thursday, August 30, 2018 at 1:30pm PST and ends on Thursday, August 30, 2018 at 2:30pm PST. The Contest Draw will be held at 2:45pm PST in the Atrium, KPU Tech, 5500 180 Street, Surrey.

6. PRIZING

There are three (3) prizes to be awarded in connection with the Contest.

Subject to the Prize Claim Conditions outlined above, the selected entrants will each be awarded one (1) of the following prizes (each a "Prize"):

1x \$200 KPU tuition waiver, total approximate value \$200

1x \$100 KPU bookstore gift card, total approximate value \$100

1x KPU hoodie, total approximate value \$50

Total approximate value of all prizes, \$350

No cash substitutions.

The tuition waiver is non-transferable and must be redeemed before the Spring 2019 semester. Waivers expire on January 31, 2019. To redeem the tuition waiver, winners must contact the Student Awards and Financial Assistance Office at KPU with the waiver they receive. Arrangements will then be made to credit their KPU student account.

7. PERSONAL INFORMATION

Kwantlen and its authorized agents will collect, use and disclose the personal information you provide when you enter the Contest for the purposes of administering the Contest and Prize fulfillment. Such personal information is collected under the authority of and will be protected, used and disclosed in compliance with British Columbia's Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.

By entering the Contest, you authorize Kwantlen Polytechnic University and its advertising and promotional agencies and their respective employees or other representatives, to broadcast, publish and otherwise use, your name, photograph, image, statements regarding the Contest and/or the Prize, and (or) voice for publicity purposes relating to the Contest, without any form of remuneration, approval or notice.

8. RELEASE

By entering this Contest, you agree to indemnify, release and hold harmless, Kwantlen Polytechnic University, its employees and its agents from and against any losses, damages, rights, claim or cause of action of any kind arising, in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, out of your breach of the Official Rules, use of the Prize or otherwise resulting from your participating in the Contest.

9. MISCELLANEOUS

Kwantlen Polytechnic University reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel or modify the Contest if fraud, technical failures, or anyone's actions destroys the integrity of the Contest, or if factors beyond the Sponsor's control make it impossible for the Sponsor to administer this Contest as planned. Entrants who have not complied with these Official Rules are subject to disqualification. The Prize is not transferable and must be accepted as awarded with no substitutions in cash or otherwise, except at Sponsor's sole discretion. Sponsor reserves the right to substitute an alternate prize of equivalent or greater value if a Prize cannot be awarded as described. The Prizes will only awarded pursuant to the Prize Claim Conditions outlined above. By entering this Contest, you agree to be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsor. All decisions of the Sponsor and/or Committee are final and binding in all matters relating to this Contest.
