












>>> Arts Course Enrolment by Faculty





>>> Students Attending Multiple Campuses


> By Semester



> By Student Status in Academic Year




>>> Number of Graduates by Credential Type




What Arts Students Tell Us - 2023 Student Satisfaction Survey


Of the 4,730 eligible Arts students registered in fall 2023, 1,427 (30%) participated in the annual survey.




How Arts Graduates Do

Of bachelor's degree graduates who took further education, 26% took another undergraduate degree (e.g., MD, dentistry, law, teacher), and 31% pursued a master's or doctoral degree.
