


Students who Studied in the 2017/18 Academic Year ¹

All students enrolled in School of Business programs, including undeclared and Pathway students




Headcount of Domestic and International Students





Key Demographics of Domestic and International Students in Business









Distribution of International and Domestic Students in Business by Credential Level ³

Top 3 International Student Countries of Origin for Business
















Sources of Funding for Education

Labour Force Participation of Business Graduates






Business Graduates who Experienced the Following Outcomes
