








>> Age Distribution of Students







>>> Students Attending Multiple Campuses


> By Semester




> By Student Status in Academic Year



>>> Business Course Enrolment by Faculty




>>> Number of Graduates by Credential Type




What Business Students Tell Us - 2023 Student Satisfaction Survey


Of the 6,740 eligible Business students registered in fall 2023, 2,306 (34%) participated in the annual survey.

>>> Funding Sources for Education & Living Expenses




How Business Graduates Do
