






Proportion of international


>> Student Enrolment Patterns




>>> Distribution of Students by Program





>>> Students Attending Multiple Campuses




>>> Number of Graduates by Credential Type




What Design Students Tell Us - 2023 Student Satisfaction Survey

Of the 421 eligible Design students registered in fall 2023, 169 (40%) participated in the annual survey.



>>> Funding Sources for Education & Living Expenses




How Design Graduates Do
