






Distribution of Students by Program




>>> Full-Time Equivalent (FTE)



>>> Key Student Demographics




>> Age Distribution of Students



>>> Students Attending Multiple Campuses








What Health Students Tell Us - 2023 Student Satisfaction Survey


Of the 469 eligible Health students registered in fall 2023, 239 (51%) participated in the annual survey.




How Health Graduates Do
