










>> Distribution of Students by Program Department








What Trades Students Tell Us - 2023 Student Satisfaction Survey

Of the 463 eligible Trades & Technology students registered in fall 2023, 140 (30%) participated in the annual survey.



Funding Sources for Education & Living Expenses






