- 1. The meeting was called to order at 11:04 am.
- Accessibility of Library facilities presentation by Marti Alger, Learning Strategist, KPU Learning Centre
 - Marti provided an overview of accessibility issues in Library facilities at KPU, and showed some possible alternatives.
 - A discussion followed the presentation, in which the committee discussed budget models that might support spending on accessibility.



- Dr. Kozak suggested PDEC make a request of SSCUB to look for budget requests to include specific provision for issues of diversity and access. Dr. Davis will discuss this with Jon Harding.
- 3. Approval of Agenda
 - The agenda of October 12, 2017 was approved as circulated.
- 4. Approval of Minutes
 - The minutes of September 14, 2017 were approved as circulated.
- 5. Director of Diversity Report
 - Most activities since the last meeting will be referenced in Business Arising. UBC will be
 offering a MOOC on reconciliation through indigenous education starting next week. There
 is no enrolment fee; a certificate of completion costs \$50. The KFA will be hosting an event
 on Pink Shirt Day (Feb. 28).

 - CCDI Bootcamp update Teresa Smith
 - The session has been scheduled for December 6th from 10:00am to 1:00pm, and will include 3 hours on Unconscious Bias and Inclusive Leadership. The December 13th workshop will pertain to PDEC mandate. On November 14th a small group will prepare the facilitators.

 - Facilities was contacted but did not provide an update.
- Aboriginal Blanket Romy Kozak
 - The blanket has been framed and is ready to hang. Narada in the International office is in the process of getting permissions to use photos of the blanket-making process to accompany the write-up.

Diversity Questions on Fall Student Survey – Romy Kozak

- IAP was very open to making changes to the survey to permit self-identification and enable cross-referencing with questions regarding diversity and inclusion.

 - Dr. Davis clarified that we are discussing alternates rather than proxies per se.
 - Several administrative reps have designated and/or sent alternates. KSA Constituency rep attendance is down again. There is a KSA by-election later this month.

- Two issues are implied, a physical space for queer students, but also safe spaces and contact people throughout campus to help support and refer to experts.
- Dr. Kozak will meet with HR reps to discuss HR's role. Possible actions will also be discussed at the CCDI workshop.
- Sponsorship Applications
 - Discussion around proposals received:
 - Should PDEC support recurring events? Maybe applications might need to build in a sustainability plan? There is a need for a formal selection criteria. For now, what fits with the Committee mandate, and what fosters diversity and equity.
 - Or. Kozak, Ruth Fraser, Dr. Seru and Kimberley McMartin will draft evaluation criteria to present to the committee in advance of the next funding round.
 - Committee decided on minimum awards based on available budget of \$6000.
 Dr. Davis will look into whether any additional funds are available to top up these amounts to closer to the full ask.
