## **Entrance Package Requirements**

Foundations in Design is a limited intake program. In addition to meeting KPU's general admission requirements, applicants must meet program specific requirements and submit an Entrance Package for review. Applicants will receive instructions on how to submit their online Entrance Package once they have completed the online application.



As part of the Entrance Package submission, applicants must submit:

### **A Video**

Create and submit a video that helps us get to know you better. Use your creativity to showcase your current skills and answer the questions provided below.

#### **Video Guidelines:**

- » Feature the applicant, be created and narrated by the applicant
- » Be a maximum length of 5 minutes
- » Be submitted as a video file (maximum 500 MB) or media link (YouTube or Vimeo)
- » Answer the following questions:
  - » Who are you? Introduce yourself.
  - » What are your current skills? Use examples of your work to explain. (Painting, drawing, photography, video/ animation, sculpture, sewing/costume design, model making, etc.)
  - » Why design? What do you hope to learn from the Foundations in Design program?
  - » Who is your favourite designer? Why?
